Has anyone at the states arts council been able to give you any direction toward funding? You might also want to find out which corporations/businesses providing matching grants for this sort of project; once you can get them committed, it's easier to find the rest of the support. (You said that you had a bad reaction from one of the oil companies, but didn't detail. Maybe it's time to ask their competition?)

This is vague, I know, but I have a feeling that you already know these things and I don't want to be repetitive. Let us know what sort of more constructive advice we could give.
