The Shrine is a memorial to the Michigan  
White Pine Forests which were ruthlessly  
slaughtered in the late 1800's and  
early 1900's Raymond Overholzer and  
his wife Harlene created beautiful and  
unique furniture from the abandoned  
rocks and stumps - It is displayed  
in a log building erected in early  
1940. Presently being purchased and  
operated by a non-profit corporation  
Shrine of the Pines, Inc.

Located on the Pen Marguette River  
so designated by the DNR + USFC as  
a wild and scenic river.

The other place you mention, Albert  
(Kid) Marty is not in this area - have  
never heard of it.
