David Hoadley sent me some information on the Liggett sculptures. Nice piece.

FYI, SPACES is a 23 year old non-profit concerned with the identification, acknowledgement, and preservation of large scale public sculpture, made in the main by those untutored in the arts. We call them contemporary folk art environments.

As far as trying to save the site. Donors or funders will need some information. Is there any documentation of the Liggett site? An inventory? A condition report? Biography, bibliography? stuff like that. Is it M.T. or M.C. Liggett.

If no information is currently available, is it possible to get the closest university or college to do a substantive documentation of the site? A least there will be some kind of a record.

Your note to David Hoadley said both Liggett wanted to donate the sculpture and that the Dodge City Area Arts Council could have to buy the land. Any other scenarios possible?

If we could talk by phone it would save a great deal of my time and move things along.
