## *Its Past*

The Humboldt Arts Council was founded on February 8, 1966, under the leadership of Dr. Homer Balabanis, Emeritus Vice President, Humboldt State University. Dr. Balabanis stated, "The Humboldt Arts Council will work to stimulate and aid art talent and activities throughout the county in all ways and endeavor to make such activity a vital influence in the life of the community".

## *Its Purpose*

The Humboldt Arts Council, a California non-profit corporation, is dedicated by charter to promoting cultural awareness and advancement of all forms of the arts in Humboldt County.

The HAC believes that the development of a broader cultural spectrum in this area contributes to its economic development and, at the same time, makes this a more desirable place in which to live.

The Arts Council assists local cultural organizations, sponsors dramatic, musical and visual presentations, and supports youth programs and special community projects.

## *Its Membership*

HAC members are individuals, organizations, and businesses who share in the support and encouragement of all forms of the arts, including music, drama, dance and the visual arts.

The HAC is governed by eleven directors, elected by the general membership for a three year term. Dr. Homer Balabanis, founding director, continues to serve as an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors.
