Pacific Gas and Electric Company AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

THIS AGREEMENT, made by and between the PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of California, hereinafter called "Pacific," and

hereinafter called "Customer," WITNESSETH that Pacific hereby promises to sell and deliver to Customer, and Customer hereby promises to purchase from Pacific, during the term hereof, all of the electricity which shall be required for the operation of Customer's electrical machinery and apparatus, and in the conduct of Customer's business upon Customer's premises situate

State of California, all in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations duly and regularly established from time to time by or under authority of law and on file with the Railroad Commission of California.

All electricity to be delivered and received pursuant to the provisions of this contract shall be what is commonly designated as 115 current and shall be metered at an electro-motive force of approximately 115 volts, slight variations in frequency and electro-motive force to be allowed.

All electricity delivered hereunder shall be paid for monthly by Customer at the office of Pacific in San Luis Obispo upon presentation to Customer of a bill therefor.

Customer shall pay Pacific for electricity and service furnished hereunder at the rates and charges duly and regularly established from time to time by or under authority of law and applicable to the furnishing of electricity and service to Customer under the conditions existing from time to time within the district in which said premises are situate, and for said purpose Customer hereby selects Schedule Domestic Lights (a copy of which is hereunto annexed), which is applicable to the service requested by Customer, to-wit:

Customer agrees that the rated capacity of the electrical machinery and apparatus to be operated hereunder shall at no time be less than
LIGHT 2.00 K. W. HEAT _____ K. W. POWER _____ H. P.

In the event of leasing or conveying said premises or the business in which such electricity is used, Customer may, with Pacific's written consent, assign this contract to the lessee or grantee thereof, if such lessee or grantee will in writing assume and covenant to perform this contract.

Customer hereby grants Pacific a right of way over the shortest practicable route for any pole and wire line which it may be necessary to build over Customer's premises for the purpose of making delivery hereunder.

This contract shall continue in force until the expiration of the term of _____, and thereafter until terminated by thirty (30) days' written notice given by either party hereto to the other of a desire for such termination.

All electricity sold hereunder shall be delivered by Pacific to Customer at the point where wires owned, leased or under license by Customer contact Pacific's wires, but for the convenience of the parties hereto said electricity may be transformed and/or metered at a location on the Customer's side of said point of delivery as shall be agreed on by the parties hereto.

Delivery of electricity hereunder shall commence on December 14, 1945

This contract shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Railroad Commission of California, as said Commission may, from time to time, direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

SCHEDULE D-9
DOMESTIC SERVICE

Description of Service:

This schedule is applicable to domestic lighting, heating, cooking and single phase domestic power service in single family dwellings and in flats and apartments separately metered by the Company; also to all single phase farm service on a farm operated by the person whose residence is supplied through the same meter.

Territory:

The entire territory served in the San Luis Obispo and Santa Maria Districts of the San Joaquin Power Division, outside of the limits of all incorporated cities and towns, except in the unincorporated towns of Pismo and Guadalupe.

Rate:

Service Charge: per meter per month.....	60¢
Energy Charge (to be added to Service Charge):	
First 40 kwh. per meter per month.....	4.8¢ per kwh.
Next 60 kwh. per meter per month.....	3.0¢ per kwh.
Next 100 kwh. per meter per month.....	2.5¢ per kwh.
All excess kwh. per meter per month:	
Months of June to September, inclusive.....	1.2¢ per kwh.
Months of October to May, inclusive.....	.9¢ per kwh.

Special Condition:

- (a) For summer cottage customers and others who regularly take service for only part of the year, this schedule is applicable only on annual contract.
- (b) For the purpose of computing charges, the months named in the rate table above are the regular monthly meter reading periods ending in each named month.
