# Your Poetry on the Air...

- ¶ Poetry House announces another of its distinguished anthologies, **POETRY ON THE AIR**, which offers three Victory Bond prizes of \$100, \$50, and \$25 to the contributors of the best poetry.
- ¶ The enthusiastic radio and literary response accorded our previous books assures a similar reception for this volume. As one newspaper wrote, "Seldom have compilers done a job equal to this; certainly no efforts were spared to make it complete. Most of the work has been heard on the air; lovers of poetry will revel in its pages."
- ¶ To meet radio requirements, poems should be under 36 lines; they should be the kind of poems you yourself would like to hear. Subject matter and style are optional; we need all types of verse.
- ¶ Submit not more than ten of your poems, published or unpublished, accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped envelope. You retain all rights to your work. We are sure you will agree with our regular contributors that this is a must anthology for you to appear in and own. Contributors receive a special purchasing discount. Manuscripts must be post-marked no later than October 28, 1946.
- ¶ **POETRY ON THE AIR** will be sent to 200 radio stations which request and broadcast from our books, as well as to 150 newspapers and magazines for review. Publicity stories on contributors will be sent to their local papers.
- ¶ If you have appeared in a Poetry House anthology before, you know that you must appear in this one, too; if you have not, here is your opportunity to join the select circle of our contributors.
