Dear Sir:

My client, Hawk Radio Company, has consulted me with reference to your unauthorized use of the title "Thanks to the Yanks" on a musical composition.

My client is the owner of a radio broadcast program entitled "Thanks to the Yanks", which has been broadcast nationally at a cost of hundreds of thousands of dollars. My client is the sole and exclusive owner of all rights in and to the title "Thanks to the Yanks", which constitutes a valuable property right which it is determined to protect. Your use of the title "Thanks to the Yanks" in connection with a musical composition is a distinct infringement and appropriation of my client's rights and constitutes unfair competition.

I trust you will make arrangements to cease further use of the title "Thanks to the Yanks" and discontinue all further infringements of my client's rights. Otherwise, I shall have no alternative but to proceed to institute appropriate action against you. Your prompt reply to this letter is requested.
