

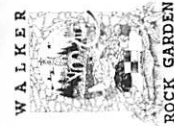

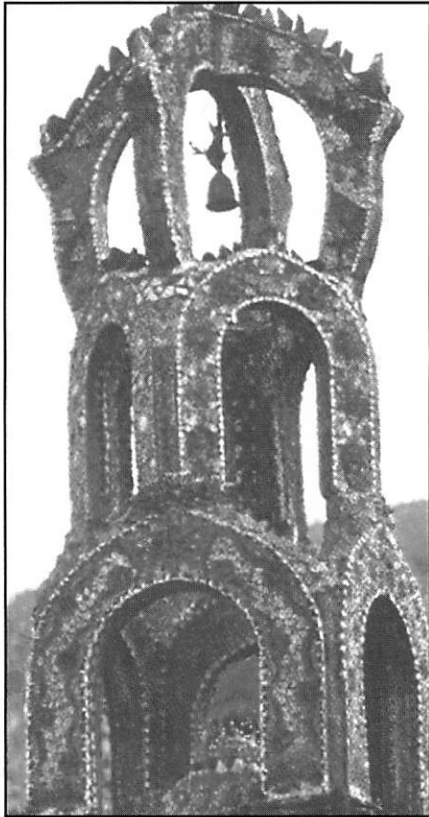

The Walker Rock Garden Purchase Fund

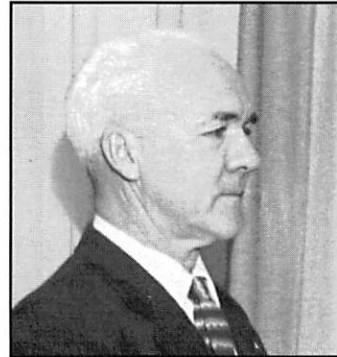
For years people have asked Florence Walker when they visited the Garden, "What's going to happen to this place?"



The Friends of the Walker Rock Garden was formed in 1987. We first gathered to repair and refurbish but gradually began to ask ourselves the same question. In 1994 we were granted tax-exempt status by the IRS. Part of the application process involved creating an official legal relationship with the Walker family, and currently the Friends are leasing the Garden from the family with an option to buy.

Thus we have enlarged our focus from maintenance and promotion of the Garden to include permanent preservation. We have established a special fund to be used exclusively for purchasing the Garden, THE WALKER ROCK GARDEN PURCHASE FUND.
