

(the non profit folk art preservation group which helped arrange the donation), they all attended the meeting when the donation was accepted and they all say the log cabin was specifically discussed and accepted. So apparently the log cabin was accepted by the college board at that time. We just need a letter to the Architects Office stating that it was accepted and that it is alright to issue the permit if all else is acceptable to them.

We will greatly appreciate any help you can give us in getting the letter we need. Dads stuff is in storage and we would all like to see it in its permanent home. It would be helpful to you to talk to Mr. McCort personally. I enclose a copy of one of his letters. Although it is signed by his supervisor, Mr. McCort is the person we've been dealing with.
