It is very exciting for me! My understanding is that galvanized pipe lasts about 25 yrs. So, the water may not last too long.

I plan on having people do some film & video to document these restorations for the centennial - (Jan 1, 1991) The Garden will be open from 5 to 7 P.M. from Dec. 25 through New Year's Day.

I now have the beginning of a Thompson museum, and an infant archives. I met some people from Kansas who are involved with the Kansas Grass Roots. Gradually, over time I will have an improved listing and slide collection depicting sites around the world. Eventually, I'd like to be able to present a course on Folk Art through the Community college network.

I hope you can return to Phoenix. I think you'd like the recent developments.
