I'd like to get a good letter writing campaign rolling - I think it is important to keep the media involved + to ~~gain~~ raise the communities level of awareness. It is amazing how much restoration has been done by the 2 women and 2 teenagers in the second article. A somewhat organized cadre of volunteer carpenters/painters/clippers/mowers/track collectors/art students/boy scouts/girl scouts/senior citizens/veterans/anarchists... could put a good dent in the weathering and crumbling which exists on Pine Hill. I amassed a good dozen names and addresses at Holyland's front gate today. Most of these people said yes when asked if they'd volunteer an hour a week for restoration. 1 hr \* 12 \* 1 hr \* 12 + 1 hr \* 12 + 1 hr \* 12... under some skilled tutelage such as Dan Price or his counterparts.
