

Duke Cahill-Contract

This agreement has been created to insure that the items listed below and gifted to the Art Collection of the City of Sacramento, shall be properly maintained, preserved and displayed beginning on the date that the items are acquired by the City of Sacramento.

If and when the City of Sacramento deems it necessary that any major changes to the art works need be addressed; including but not limited to: structural repair, relocation or repainting of the art works; the parties listed below shall receive prior notification, (within 2 weeks), before the changes are initiated.

If the time arrives when the City of Sacramento deems the pieces to be deacquisitioned from the collection; the City of Sacramento agrees to arrange that the pieces shall be

donated to a non-profit arts organization; be it local or not; who will also be responsible for upholding the aforementioned agreed upon conditions.

The City of Sacramento shall also be responsible for the fabrication and timely installation, (within 2 months), of corresponding plaques indentifying "Duke Cahill" as the primary creator, along with the "Title" and approximate date the creation was produced. The corresponding identification plaques shall be installed with the artworks in the best and most appropriate manner.
