A scene on STOW LAKE in the high central part of famed GOLDEN GATE PARK, San Francisco, California.

The Boating and Picnic activities around Strawberry Hill on the Lake are real typical sights. The Gondola in center is occupied by The Muse or "Spirit of the Park" drifting and reflecting on other memorable Park sights as shown above the Lake, such as The Conservatory — Band Stand — Japanese Tea Garden — De Young Museum — Aquarium — Seal Pond — Baseball — Tennis — Donkey Course — Merry Go Round — Stone Refreshment Building — High Slide — Swings — Portals of the Past — Farm House — Hot Dog Stand — Kiddies' Sand Pit — Gravity Ride — Dutch Wind Mill — Deer Park — Polo.
