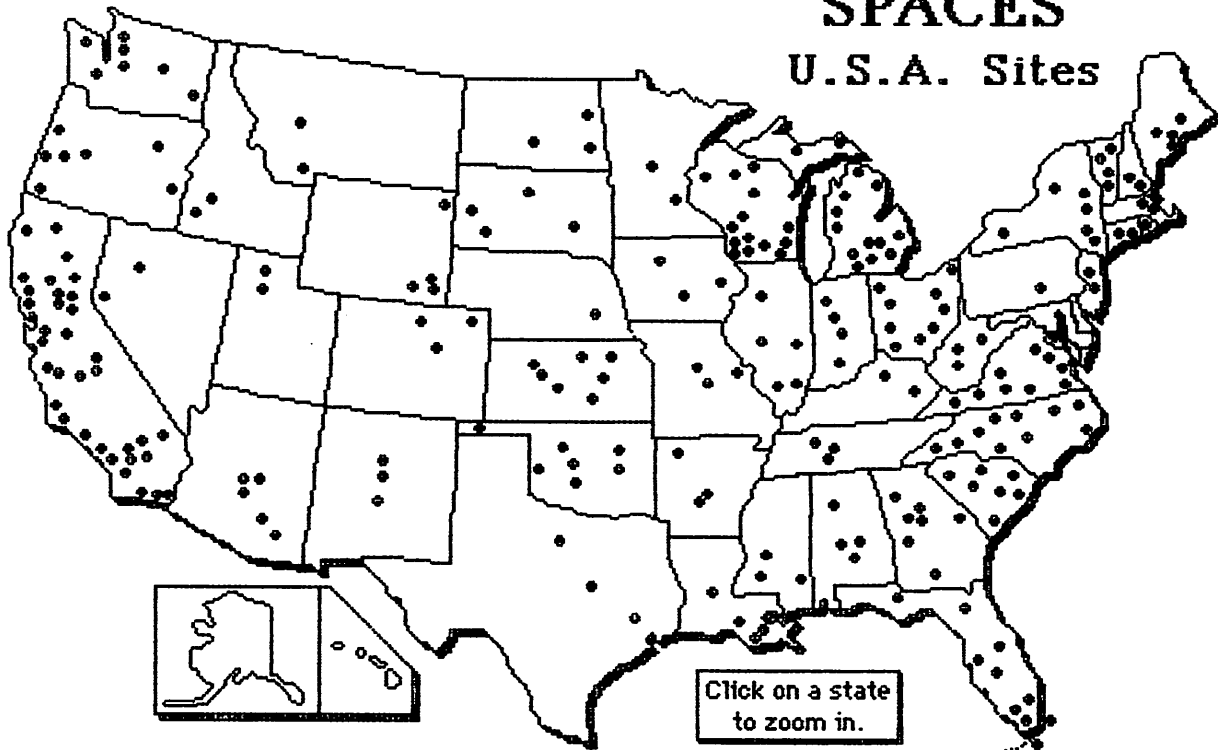

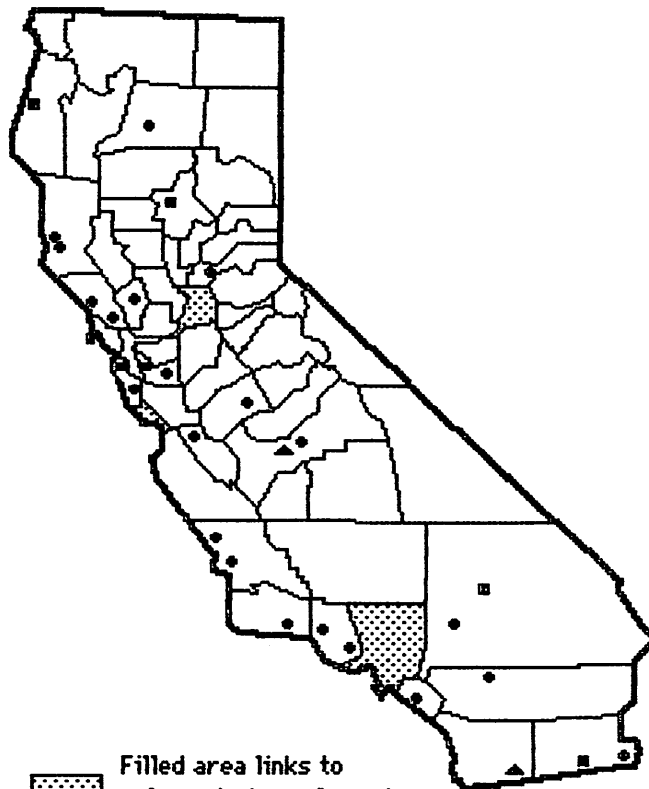
U.S.A. Sites

Bottle Village

Tressa was born on January 19, 1896 to Catherine and Matthew Shafer in the small farming community of Easton, near Wells, Minnesota. In 1912, at the age of 15, Tressa married 52 year old Theodore Grinolds. Sometime in the late 1920's Tressa left her husband, with some of her seven children, and settled in Minot, North Dakota.

After Grinold's death in the 1930's, Tressa moved to Simi Valley where she married Al Prisbrey in 1947. In the 1950's Tressa took the wheels off the family
