In reviewing our files, we see that we haven't heard from you in response to our letter of August 23. Knowing that life in hectic in a television studio, we wanted to refresh you on the subject of our letter which might understandably have been set aside.

SPACES is a non-profit organization involved in the preservation and documentation of "folk art environments"--unique, large-scale, hand-built monuments such as the Watts Towers in Los Angeles. One project we're currently involved with is in attempting to achieve state landmark status for the home of John Medica in Santa Rosa.

We're very concerned with the future of this remarkable home and yard, and as much involved with the preservation of documentation on the site as in the preservation of the site itself. It's possible that KCRA may have filmed at the Medica home within the past five years. If that filming took place, we would very much like to have that information and, if possible, a duplication of the film if it still exists. Any film which is given or sold at duplication cost to SPACES would be duly credited for our national archives.

Would it be possible for you to let us know if that film exists, and if so, we could be provided with a copy for our scholarship and archival purposes?
